#### Mode of Application

Candidates who wish to apply for **government sponsorship** will complete the PUJAB forms and those who wish to apply for the **private scheme** will complete **Form B1**. The application form with paying in slip will be collected from Busitema University (25km from Tororo), or from Busitema University Liaison Office, Lincoln Flats, Room C4 Makerere University, Arapai Campus in Soroti, Namasagali Campus, in Kamuli & Mbale Campus. An application fee of UgX 50,000 for East Africans or UgX 75,000 for Non East African candidates will be paid by all applicants **EXCEPT** those of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery who will be required to pay a non refundable fee for the special entry examination of UgX 150,000 for East Africans and UgX 225,000 for non East Africans. All payments should be paid using a paying in slip in any Stanbic or Centenary Bank branches with a bank charge of UgX 3,000. A receipt for the application / special entry examination fee will be issued on presentation of a valid paying in bank slip.

Completed application forms, application fee receipts and copies of all the supporting documents must be returned to the above offices not later than **Friday, 9th May, 2014. All copies of academic transcripts must be certified by the awarding institutions.**

#### NOTES:

- You are advised against submitting false information or forged documentations.
- Candidates who obtained results 7, 9, X, Y and Z at 'O' Level need not apply, since they do not meet the admission requirements.
