ERASMUS STUDENT MOBILITY FOR STUDIES WITH PARTNER COUNTRIES WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE 2025-1-TR01-KA171-HED-000341674 PROJECT

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Erasmus+ KA171 is an exchange program conducted with partner universities in countries **outside the European Union**. The countries and institutions included in the Erasmus+ KA171 project are provided in the table. Student mobility will only be carried out in the fields specified in the project and with the project partner institutions. Exchange with another institution in the relevant partner country is not possible.

The countries, fields, and quotas available for application are given below.

1. Applications are free of charge.
2. All full-time undergraduate students enrolled may apply. The applicant must be a full-time student during the period in which they plan to carry out the mobility.
3. The applicant should be a student at the faculty of management sciences in Busitema University pursuing a bachelor of Business Administration and should have completed year one with no outstanding academic debt.
4. Undergraduate students cannot apply while they are in the Preparatory class.
5. The applicant must have a minimum GPA/CGPA of 3.60/3.60.



6. Successful applicants are required to have valid English language proficiency certificate, tenable from Makerere University as proof of their English language competence.
7. The duration of the study mobility is one semester. This period cannot be reduced except in cases of force majeure. If the mobility period is below the minimum duration, no grant payment will be made for the mobility, and the student will be reported as a zero-grant participant.
8. The mobility will take place during 2026-2027 Fall Term (September -).

EVALUATION

The criteria and weighted scores to be used in the evaluation of Erasmus+ International Student Mobility applications are given below:

EVALUATION CRITERIA AND WEIGHTED SCORES

Criteria	Weighted Score
Academic achievement level	50% (out of 100 total points)
Language level	50% (out of 100 total points)
For students with disabilities (provided that the disability is documented)	+10 points
For students who have a protection, care or shelter decision under Law No. 2828 on Social Services and Law No. 5395 on Child Protection	+10 points
Previous participation (with or without grant)	-10 points
Participating in mobility in the country of citizenship	-10 points
Participating in mobility without submitting a waiver notice within the specified period after being selected	-10 points
Applying for two mobility types at the same time (reduction is applied to the mobility type preferred by the student)	-10 points

Note that the grant is a competitive one and selection will be on merit based on the above selection criteria



FUNDING

Students benefiting from Erasmus+ KA171 mobility are granted a scholarship to help with additional expenses incurred while being abroad during their activity period. The scholarships do not cover all activity-related expenses but are only a contribution. The amount of the scholarship to be given is determined by the European Union Commission for the destination country within the dates specified in the approved teaching/training program before departure. The monthly scholarship amount to be given to students benefiting from the activity is €700.

Grant payments are made in **two installments**. The first payment corresponds to 70% of the total grant (individual support + travel grant). The remaining 30% is paid after the mobility, provided that the student fulfills the necessary obligations. Students may participate in the activity without receiving a grant if they wish. Non-grant students are still subject to the general evaluation along with other applicants and follow the same process as students receiving grants.

Students who will study under Erasmus+ Mobility with Partner Countries will receive, in addition to the monthly grant, an amount to cover travel costs corresponding to the travel distance. The travel amount is calculated using the "Distance Calculator" (https://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/resources/distance-calculator_en).

SELECTION AND PLACEMENT

- The selection of candidate students is made based on the ranking of students with the highest scores within the quota for each faculty/department.
- Students who are selected and allocated a grant in a contract year but cannot be sent due to insufficient funding or other reasons cannot be directly sent in the next contract year as a "vested right."
